

**PROSTART (Hotel, Motel, & Restaurant Operations) - 3 Credits**

**PREREQUISITES:**

1. Ability to multiply and divide fractions.
2. Ability to read on a 6th grade level.
3. Must attend school at least 90% of the time that school is in session.
4. Recommended: At least one (1) Foods class in High School Home Ec.

**DESCRIPTION:**
